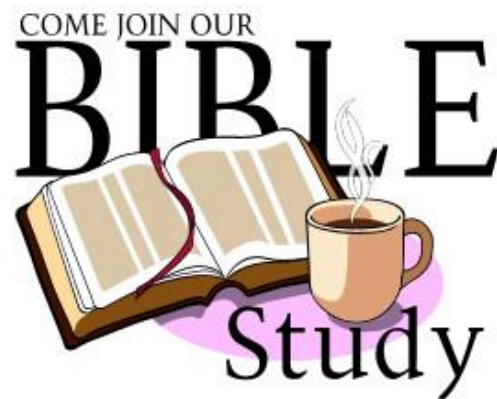


that God would take care of them. So they were free to give. They knew that they were in good hands—the Lord’s hands.
